

Jemma Yeadon Does It Again!




Jemma was selected to the ALL-ACC Academic Team and also featured in the Notre Dame Athletics: Best of 2017. Jemma a neuroscience and behavior major in the College of Science at Notre Dame, killed it in Volleyball, averaging a team-high 3.91 kills per set to total 453 for the season. She also added 315 digs, 70 blocks, and 29 aces.

Jemma was one of Notre Dame's most consistent hitters

all season, posting double-digit kills in 26-of 30 matches she played in during the year. Additionally, Jemma recently posted a career high of 27 kills against Syracuse, the most any Notre Dame student-athlete has logged in a match since the 2012 season.
















Outreach Ministry - Homeless Feeding Going Beyond the Walls of the Church
