Saved To Serve

Servanthood is by far one of the most important characteristics of Christian discipleship. We have all heard it said plenty of times from Pastor Braxton and others that, "We are saved to serve, not to sit." The word of God reminds us as well that we're to be about servanthood and there is a place for all to serve. God has given each of us a unique set of talents, which we should willingly use to serve Him and others. True servanthood is not driven by self-centeredness. Rather, it is selfless and not self-serving. We serve because we love the Lord and want to please Him.

In a message by Pastor Braxton titled "A Wasted Harvest," he reminds us that it is our responsibility as followers of Christ to prepare God's harvest; Jesus himself has given us this responsibility. The question was raised, why would the Lord be talking about a labor shortage when the house of the Lord is full? The an-

swer, because we confuse Christian servanthood with volunteerism. As Pastor noted, the difference between servanthood and volunteerism is that volunteers tend to be lazy, self-serving etc., opposed to true disciples who know they are chosen/elected by God for service. The favor of God is on us. As he noted, real disciples of Jesus stand ready for service with a case of the "can't help its." We build the kingdom with disciples not volunteers. When it comes to servanthood compensation is not the issue; commission however is. God cannot do anything with people who take things for granted.

As the need for ministry workers continues to build, it is our earnest prayer that each member of NBCF will look within and willingly, and enthusiastically step up and share their unique gift with the body of Christ,

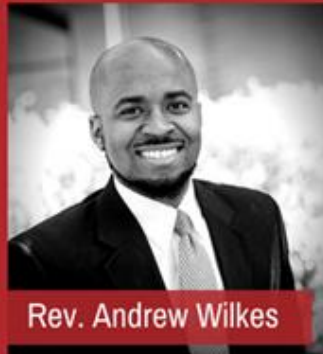

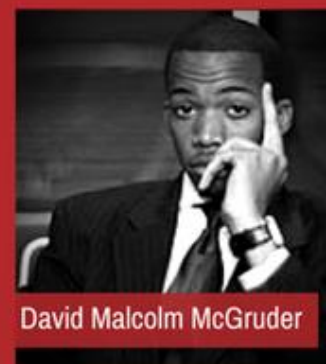

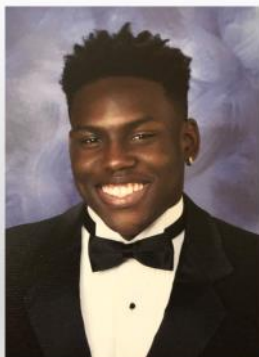

On March 24, 2018, Rhonda participated in the USA of Washington Rookie (first timers) Power-lifting Competition!. Competing in 3 events: Squats, Bench Press and Dead-lifts, she accomplished the following, which earned her a Gold Medal for her age and weight class::

Squats- 77lbs (all 3 lifts)

Bench Press- (1st)82.7lbs, (2nd)88.2lbs, (3rd)99.2lbs

Deadlifts- (1st) 143.3lbs, (2nd) 154.3lbs), (3rd) 165.3lbs

When asked what got her started in this arena, Rhonda states, "I have been working out at my gym Vigor Ground in Renton since they opened doing Bootcamps and weight training.

It wasn't until 2 years ago when I attended my youngest daughter, Erin's power-lifting competition that I "caught the bug". I saw a Sister that was 75 years old competing and a gentleman who was walking with 2 canes competing and I said to myself, "If they can do this, I know I can!" and so my journey began.

At my next weight training session, I informed my trainer that I wanted to begin to prepare for a power-lifting competition and we began. The preparation began with various stretches, aerobic work (mainly Bootcamp), learning proper technique of the lifts, proper gear to wear (shoes, belts etc.) as well as proper nutrition, hydration and sleep. Over the 2 year training period, I was slowly increased in the amount of weight that I could lift. I also had a motto that I wore regularly on my shirt, "I CAN, I WILL, END OF STORY".

My future aspiration is to set a State Record! After the competition, I checked my age and weight class and to date there is not a State Record so I feel that the door is open for me to achieve this goal in the next year or 2 SO.....

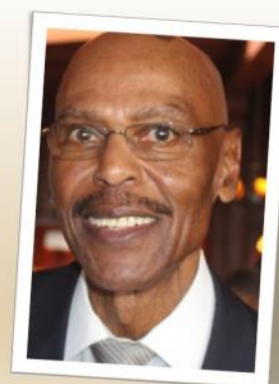

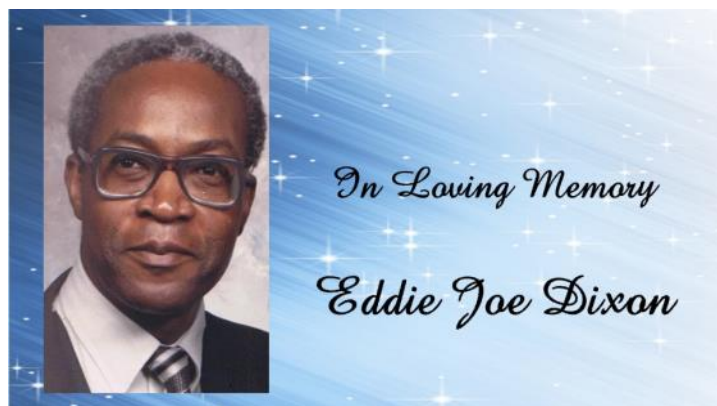

HOT WEATHER WARNING



It's officially summer! That means sunny days, warm temperatures, & lots of outdoor activities. It's also important to keep in mind safety & health tips. The CDC reminds us to do three things: Stay cool, Stay hydrated, and Stay informed.

Stay cool

- Wear loose, lightweight, light-colored clothing.
- Take cool showers or baths to cool down.
- Do not engage in very strenuous activities and get plenty of rest.
- Use broad spectrum sunscreen with sun protection factor (SPF) of 15 or higher.

Stay hydrated

- Drink more water than usual and don't wait until you're thirsty to drink.
- If your doctor limits the amount of fluids you drink or has you on water pills, ask them how much you should drink during hot weather.

Stay informed

- Check the local news for health and safety updates.
- Seek medical care immediately if you have, or someone you know has, symptoms of heat-related illness like muscle cramps, headaches, nausea or vomiting.
- Remember our elders, check on a friend or neighbor and have someone do the same for you.
